Selection method under this tender will be QCBS(Quality and cost base selection method). 60% weightage shall be given for technical criteria and 40% weightage shall be given to financial bid.

Technical score obtained in above criteria will be multiplied with 0.6 for individual bidders technical score for overall bid comparison

Financial rate comparison shall be done on the basis of 80:20 weightage ratio. In which 80% weightage shall be given to the rates quoted by vendor for monthly meal charges as per BoQ and 20% weightage shall be given to the monthly facility reimbursement charges (to be paid

to ACCF by the Service Provider). Method for financial bid scoring:

- 1) successful vendor shall be decided based on percentile method
- 2) lowest rate offered by vendor for meal will get 100 percentile and others quoted rate will be converted accordingly to percentile like who has quoted double than the lowest will get 50%.
- 3) Highest average Facility utilization reimbursement offered by vendor shall be given 100 percentile and others quoted rate will be converted accordingly to percentile

After calculating individual percentile, it will be fractionated in 80:20 ratio and then it shall be totaled up to get total financial score of individual bidder.

For overall bid comparison and deriving successful vendor: Individual bidders total core = Technical score*0.6+Financial score*0.4

Individual bidder who gets highest total score will be declared as successful bidder and will be considered for award of tender.
